Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Perhaps you are...

- A Baptized Catholic with very little religious formation?
- A Christian who was baptized and raised in a different denomination?

The **R.C.I.A.** is an exploration of the essentials of the Catholic faith in a series of weekly meetings. It is an opportunity to ask those questions you have always had, and to explore your own faith and membership in the Church.

R.C.I.A. is not a course with papers and marks, nor is it an encounter session. Rather, it is a weekly gathering with like-minded inquirers, parishioners and parish staff; a place to learn more about God's revelation in Jesus Christ and the life of the Church that Jesus founded.

In order to take advantage of the new **Free Subscription of Formed**, follow these very easy steps.

1. Go to **formed.org** on your device.
2. Click register on the bottom right of the picture.
3. Type the Parish/Diocesan Code (**J8G6NJ**) and your email then click “GO”. *There is a short video to help you, under need help. Fill in your name, address and create a password (at least 6 characters)*
4. Check the box indicating that you understand the terms and click “submit”.
5. Go to your email and click the link to activate your account. Just LOGIN at the top right corner any time you return to **formed.org** with your email and password you created.
